

TRAVEL INFORMATION - SUMMER 2021

The "Green Passport":

Upon arrival we ask you to show us a valid negative test result, a vaccination certificate or a confirmation of a passed COVID-19 disease.

Period of validity:

- Self-testing under supervision at a facility, but valid only for the duration of the individual stay/access.
- Antigen test for self-administration that is recorded in an official data processing system: **24 hours**
- Antigen test: Evidence from an authorized source (test lane, pharmacy, etc.) of a negative result: **48 hours**
- PCR test: **72 hours**

Recovered persons:

- Segregation notice if issued for a person documented to have been ill with SARS-CoV-2 in the six months prior to the scheduled testing.
- Medical confirmation of a molecularly confirmed infection that has occurred in the last six months and is currently expired.
- Proof of neutralizing antibodies (antibody test), which must not be older than three months

Proof of vaccination

- First vaccination counts as proof from day 22 and then counts as proof for three months from vaccination for admissions or for nine months if you already had COVID-19 21 days before first vaccination
- Second vaccination is valid as proof for nine months from the initial vaccination
- For vaccinations where only one vaccination is scheduled, it will count as proof from day 22, and will then count as proof for nine months from vaccination for admissions.

In the future, Austria will be guided by the **ECDC card** for risk areas for entry of guests:

- green/orange: free entry
- red: entry only for tested, vaccinated or recovered persons
- dark red: entry only for tested, vaccinated or recovered persons plus quarantine
- (free testing after 5 days)
- Entry will be possible without quarantine from countries with a 14-day incidence below 500 (equivalent to a 7-day incidence of 250), which are not virus mutation areas.

Entry from Germany - May 2021: from 19.5.2021 entry from Germany is possible without quarantine in Austria. Also on the return journey to Germany it is called recovered, vaccinated or tested - **without quarantine.**
